**ORDER:**

The Transport Commissioner, has reported that one of the biggest problems facing the Transport Department now is the inadequacy of staff in relation to the growing number of vehicles. He has stated that the piece-meal proposals for staff sent to Government were turned down on the ground of economy. But the fact remains that day-by-day the registration of vehicles are on the increase by leaps and bounds, and consequently the work load in the Transport Department is increasing enormously and that the staff are not in a position to cope with the increased work load. This leads to malpractices in the offices of Regional Transport offices, unit offices, etc., and the public are put to lot of hardships. He has, therefore, suggested that a unit of a consisting of the following should be sanctioned, for every registration of 10,000 vehicles in an office so as to cope with the increase in administrative work.

Motor Vehicles Inspector Grade I	:	1
Motor Vehicles Inspector Grade II	:	1
Superintendent	:	1
Assistants	:	2
Junior Assistants	:	3
Typist	:	1
Office Assistant	:	1

He also suggested that Transport Commissioner may be empowered to create the staff on the above pattern in each office where the 10,000 norm is reached, without coming to Government every now and then.

2. The Government have examined the proposal very carefully and fix the norms for the creation of additional staff on the pattern mentioned below for every 10,000 vehicles registered in every Regional Transport office/unit office in Transport Department.

Motor Vehicles Inspector Grade I	:	1
Motor Vehicles Inspector Grade II	:	1
Superintendent	:	1
Assistants	:	2
Junior Assistant	:	3

This will be subject the following conditions.

- i) In computing the vehicles strength of 10,000 vehicles of 50 cc and below capacity should be excluded.
- ii) The above norms should be followed from 01.04.92
- iii) The Transport Commissioner will obtain Government sanction for the creation of staff in the pattern mentioned above as and when 10,000 vehicles are registered excluding 50 cc vehicles.
- iv) All posts of Junior Assistants will be filled up by re-deployment from the junior Assistants founds surplus under UDR scheme, till it fully exhausted.
