Order:

In G.O.Ms.No.1311, Home (Transport) Department,, dated:13.7.1989, Government have issued orders among other things fixing the Ceiling limit on expenditure on petty and minor repairs without referring to Government Automobile Workshops by the vehicle owning officers of various local bodies, municipalities, Boards, Quasi-Government Departments and Autonomous Institutions, etc., under the Government of Tamil Nadu as below:-

Light vehicle - Rs.500/-

Heavy vehicles - Rs.800/-

The frequency of such repairs shall not be more than once in a month.

2 In G.O.Ms.No.2503, Transport ,dated: 18.9.91, Government have revised the existing financial powers of the vehicle using officers to incur expenditure towards petty and minor repairs such as, servicing, battery charging, tyre retreading etc., within the overall ceiling fixed with reference to G.O.Ms,1311, Home Department, dated:13.7.89.

3. The Director of Employment and Training , the Secretary, Tamilnadu Public service Commission, the Director of Information& Public Relations, the Chairman , Tamil nadu Public Service Commission, the Director of Technical Education and the Director of Collegiate Education have requested the Government to enhance the existing financial powers of the vehicle using officers to incur expenditure on petty and minor repairs without referring to Government Automobile workshop.

4. The Government examined the above request in consultation with the Director, Motor Vehicle Maintenance Department had suggested that the powers vested with the vehicle using officers in G.O.Ms.No.2503, Transport, dated: 18.9.91 may be enhanced considering the present cost of repairs and in view of the general increase in the prices of the Automobile Components and the labour charges. Accordingly,. he has sent the proposal to revise the existing financial powers to the Government.

5. The Government after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Director, Motor Vehicle Maintenance Department and Direct that the existing financial powers of the vehicle using officers to incur expenditure towards petty and minor repairs such as, servicing, battery charging, tube vulcanizing /replacement of electrical items, etc., and tyre retreading without referring to Government Automobile Workshop within the overall ceiling fixed with reference to G.O.Ms.No.1311, Home, dated:13.7.1989 be enhanced as detailed below:-

ORDER:

Under Rule 15(2) of the Tamil Nadu Departmental Vehicles Control Rules 1976, the officer in charge of the Government Vehicle can incur expenditure to carryout repairs and replacement of spare parts of Government Vehicle upto the certain limit pres limit prescribed from time to time. Such a ceiling limit on expenditure on repairs and replacement for light vehicles was last fixed in G.O.Ms.No.1311, Home dated 13.7.1989. Meanwhile, there was further increase in the overall cost of spares, labour, etc. The Director, Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department was therefore, requested to make his recommendation for revision of ceiling on repairs. The Director Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department has recommended revision of ceiling on repairs and incurring expenditure on minor repairs by vehide owning officer without referring to the Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department at the time of emergencies. The Transport Commissioner has also agreed to the proposal.

2. The proposal of the Director, Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department has been examined carefully. The Government have decided to accept the same.

3. Accordingly, the Government direct that, the ceiling limit on expenditure on repairs and replacement for light vehicles (Petrol), Light Vehicle (Diesel) and Heavy vehicle(Diesel) be fixed as indicated below:-

3.The Government also direct that the ceiling limit on expenditure for petty and minor repairs of the vehicle, by vehicle owning office without referring to the Automobile workshops at the time of emergencies shall be as indicated below:

Light Vehicle - Petrol- Diesel Rs.750/-

Heavy Vehicle - Diesel Rs. 1200/-

4. The Government also direct that in respect of petty and miner repairs, the orders issued by transport Department in G.O.Ms.No.6, Transport, dated 4.1.2000 shall continue to prevail.
